The goods and services being offered today have been donated by parishioners of this church, our friends, neighbors, and local businesses.

All sales are final unless an item has been misrepresented in this catalog. Take time to examine all items carefully as all are sold "as is." Cash, credit card, or personal check with printed address and phone number are gratefully accepted.

Please register at the auction table if you wish to bid on an item. You must supply your name and contact number to receive a bidding paddle. This is to ensure that all sold items get to the proper bidder and to assist us in the rare event that something goes amiss with any transaction. There is no charge to participate in this auction.

During the auction, the auctioneer will suggest a price for each item in turn. If you would like to purchase the item and are willing to pay that price, raise your paddle to be recognized by the auctioneer. If there are multiple paddles displayed, the auctioneer will offer incrementally higher prices until only one paddle is left raised. If no other bidders join the bidding at the next price offered, the bidder holding the last raised paddle wins the item.

At the conclusion of the auction, (or as soon as you are finished with your bidding) you may turn in your paddle and pay for your item(s) at which point your name and contact information will be expunged. You may rest assured that no one from the UMC at LR will contact you. If you would like to be contacted or wish to be on our mailing list of upcoming events, please let an auction attendant know.

All items won shall be taken from the premises by the winning bidders at the close of the auction.
