Personal circumstances required that our annual Christmas Cantata be held a few weeks earlier than usual on the first Sunday in Advent. It required a mighty push by all involved, but the result was well worth the effort. A very moving rendering of "The Winter Rose" by Joseph Martin was presented accompanied by a 14 piece chamber orchestra. Guests Henry Finnegan, Robin Schmidt, and Karen Limardo added their voices to the choir while Doris Coniglio handled the narration with her usual consummate skill.

The choir has been blessed with two new members: Cheryle Otto, soprano and Pamela Bowman, alto. Also, Bill Dobos has returned to the bass section after a long hiatus in which he tended to his wife's medical needs. Maria, we are happy to report, is doing well after enduring open heart surgery.

Spring is just around the corner. That means we will be starting work on the special music for Easter week. The choir always presents a flurry of beautiful and sustaining works throughout the week. Although specific works have not been finalized, one can expect brasses to join us for Palm Sunday, Strings for Holy Thursday and/or Good Friday, and the "Illumination" Praise Band for Easter morning.

Coming up soon, in recognition of Black History Month, the choir is planning to present works by Pulitzer Prize winning American composer William Grant Still. Watch for the announcement in late February.

Also expect poignant and inspirational special music for Memorial Day in June.

We will wrap up the year with our usual surprise lunacy on Choir Recognition Sunday.

If you, or anyone whom you know, would like to join the choir, we meet every Wednesday evening from 7:30 to 9:00. We are not looking for trained singers (although some vocal experience is a good thing) - only generous folks who love to sing and serve. We are in particular need of male voices at this juncture. Church Choir seeking new voices

The Chancel Choir of the United Methodist Church of Lake Ronkonkoma is actively seeking vocal talent to augment its numbers.

A local landmark that has faithfully served our community since 1796, the “Church at Five Corners” maintains its mission to strengthen our community - regionally and globally - through service in the name of Christ.

The choir is presently under the leadership of Dr. Rex Enderlin (BME - University of the Pacific, MM - University of Tennessee, DMA - SUNY Stony Brook). The choir has, under Dr. Enderlin’s direction, presented eclectic introits and anthems in traditional four-part format every Sunday for the past nine years exploring as many styles as possible from mediaeval plainchant to contemporary gospel, with an occasional foray into opera, musical theater, and pop.

Assisting at the organ and piano is Heather Edwards-Wilson, a young woman whose prodigious musical talents include singing, composing, and arranging in addition to her duties at the keyboard, with the Children’s Choir, and leading “Illumination,” our once-a-month praise band.

Our current pastor, Rev. Dr. Constance Y. Pak, is an enthusiastic and open minded supporter of the church’s music ministry.

Membership in the congregation is not a requirement for new choristers. The only requisite is the desire to sing and to serve. The United Methodist Church of Lake Ronkonkoma welcomes all.

The choir rehearses every Wednesday evening in the sanctuary at 792 Hawkins Ave., Lake Grove from 7:30 to 9:00. 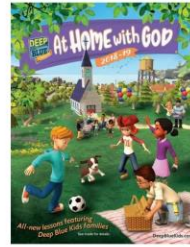

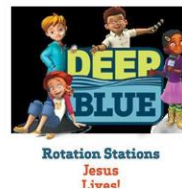

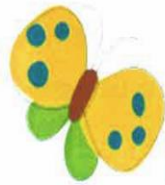
