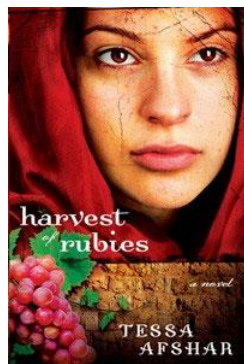
## *Come celebrate the poetry of Barbara Meyers*

- Security Cameras installed in our main complex by Securetel, our alarm company. The new security system was paid for by donations already received.

50 clothespins

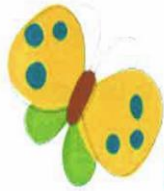

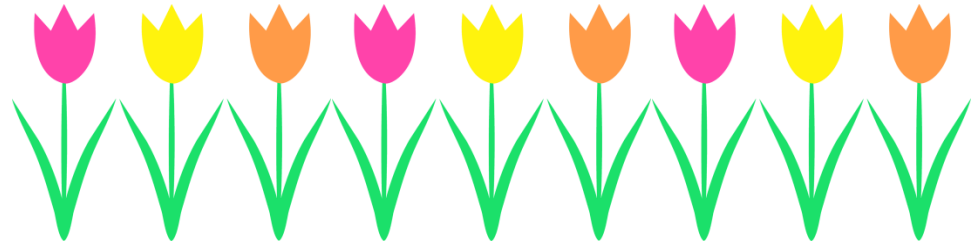
